
Questionnaire Design for Cross-Cultural Survey Research





GOAL

To construct questions that allow for the collection of reliable and valid data that is representative of the population of interest.

- Don't use biasing language
- Ask about one concept at a time
- Construct exhaustive and mutually exclusive response options
- Specify the response task

Attitude Questions

Attitude Questions

Measure someone's views or feelings on a topic

Cannot be fact checked

Attitude Questions

Measure someone's views or feelings on a topic

Cannot be fact checked

Behavioral: Did you vote in the last election? vs.

Attitudinal: What was your biggest motivation for voting in the last election?

Answers to attitude questions are fluid and can change often.

Beliefs and perceptions are complex ideas.

Fluid Attitudes

Q2a. Would you say security in your local area is good, fair or poor? Is that 'very good/poor'?

Q2b. Would you say security on local roads is good, fair or poor? Is that 'very good/poor'?





Understand external conditions that influence attitudes

Question order can have profound effect on responses to your attitude question.



Question Order Effect

Election Survey A and Election Survey B were used to project the number of likely voters in the Afghanistan presidential election (held April 2014).

Question Order Effect

Election Survey A and Election Survey B were used to project the number of likely voters in the Afghanistan presidential election (held April 2014).

The percentage of respondents who were likely to vote was off by 15%.... WHY?

Example of Question Order


Election Survey A: Likelihood of voting question followed questions about past voting behavior

Election Survey B: Likelihood of voting question followed questions about security

Tips for Question Order

- Consider how other questions frame respondents' thinking
- Open-ended questions before closed-ended questions
- Start with warm-up questions
- Consider respondent fatigue

Research question: How do Egyptians perceive legitimacy of their newly formed government?

Research question: How do Egyptians perceive legitimacy of their newly formed government?

Favorability: Q36a. Do you have a very favorable, somewhat favorable, somewhat unfavorable, or very unfavorable view of the government?

Confidence: Q36b. How do you feel about the government's ability to govern fairly – very confident, somewhat confident, not so confident or not confident at all?

Support: Q36c. How do you feel about most decisions made by the government – do you support them strongly, support them somewhat, oppose them somewhat or oppose them strongly?



Ask simple questions. Avoid double barreled questions.

Double Barreled Question

Q-11. Do you think the Iraqi Government provides services and aid to all Iraqis equally or do they favor one group or actor over the others?

- 1. Yes, provides services and aid to all Iraqis equally
- 2. No, favors one group over others

Knowledge Questions

Knowledge Questions

Measure effectiveness of an educational process

Measure knowledge in order to effectively design and implement information programs or advertising campaigns

Measure intelligence, which may be required to explain behavioral and attitudinal variables



Ask knowledge questions to screen out respondents who lack information about a topic

Screening Questions

Q-27. Biometric fingerprint scanners are scheduled to be used in the 2015 presidential election in Yemen. Are you aware of Yemen's planned new biometric voting registry?







Of those who are aware, the overwhelming majority support it.




Educational Achievement in Yemen




Behavior Questions

Intent: to accurately record past, present or future behaviors

 Need to be carefully written to encourage truthful responses and avoid unintended distortions

Understand the behavioral norms in the country where you're working





Q15. In a typical week, please tell me if you engage in each of the following activities AT LEAST 2 DAYS WEEK for at least 10 minutes each day?

- a. Exercise or play sports
- b. Walk or ride a bicycle
- c. Do strenuous household chores like cleaning or gardening



Recall

Time Elapsed: memory diminishes over time

Saliency: easier to remember details of salient events

Long time elapse, low salience:

How much did you, yourself spend in total on potato chips in January 2011?

Timeframe and Salience Negative Interplay

Long time elapse, low salience:

How much did you, yourself spend in total on potato chips in January 2011?

Short time elapse, high salience:

Did you, yourself get married last week?

Timeframe and Salience Positive Interplay

Long time elapse, high salience:

Where were you when the terrorist attacks in New York and Washington DC on September 11, 2001 happened?

Short time elapse, low salience:

How much money, if any, did you spend at restaurants yesterday?


Aided Recall

Aided recall provides the respondent with memory cues or external sources of information to reduce recall errors.

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Aided recall provides the respondent with memory cues or external sources of information to reduce recall errors.

 Use when concerned with under-reporting, not overreporting.


This includes travel time to the source, wait time at the source, and return time. For bottled water, this refers to the amount of time it takes to travel to the shop, buy the water, and return.



Sensitive Questions

Sensitive Questions

Any survey question dealing with a sensitive or potentially threatening topic, where special measures should be taken to increase respondent ease and encourage truthful responses.

'Sensitive' Questions: Haiti

Q12. Have you ever given birth to a boy or girl who was born alive but later died?

PROBE: Any baby who cried or showed signs of life but did not survive?

Factors that Impact Sensitivity

- Legal restrictions on free speech
- Religious or ethnic taboos
- Different concepts of public and private information

Understand the true ramifications of asking a sensitive question.



Sensitive Questions: Iraq

Q6. Who provides security in your neighborhood? (Open-ended with pre-codes, DO NOT READ LIST)

IMPORTANT: If respondent says "The Islamic State of Iraq and Al-Sham, ISIS, Islamic State and Da'esh" Skip to Demographics and END interview

The Casual Approach

Q-36. Thinking about voting, if you happen to know, can you tell me the location where people living in this voting precinct will go to cast their ballot on election day, or is this something you don't know?

- Yes, knows the location
- 2. No, does not know location



The Everybody Approach

Q6. As you know, many people in this area grow poppy along with other crops like wheat. Do you yourself happen to grow poppy?

- 1. Yes, grow poppy.
- 2. No, do not grow poppy.



The Some/Other Approach

Q40. Some people think that sending girls to school is doing what the Qur'an and Hadith teach. Other people think that sending girls to school goes against the teachings of the Qur'an and Hadith. Which is closer to your view?

- Sending girls to school is doing what the Quran and Hadith teach
- Sending girls to formal school goes against the teachings of the Qur'an and Hadith.



Tips: Socially Undesirable Questions

Deliberately load the question:

- "Everybody does it..."
- Assume the behavior, ask about frequency

Ask "have you ever" before asking "do you currently"

Tips: Socially Desirable Questions

Use the casual approach "Do you happen to..."

 Ask "do you currently" rather than "do you usually"

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 Ask "do you currently" rather than "do you usually"


In all cases... avoid reliability checks within the same questionnaire!






How many cigarettes have you smoked in the past year?




